What is Orienteering?

What do I need to do?

Check online before setting off on the day. Arrive between 09:00 and 10:30; wear sensible shoes and sun protection; bring water. If you are planning to bring a group, please let us know so that we can print extra maps. *This is a low-key introductory event designed for novices and youngsters with more challenging courses for adults. It's nothing like that boring compass / pace counting exercise they made you do at school camp!*
